



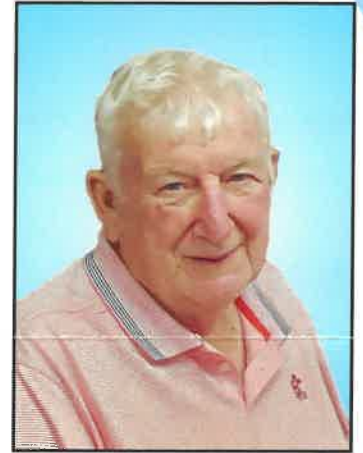

ROBERT WILSON LEAVES BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Robert Wilson served as La Habra Heights County Water District Board of Director for 20 years. Mr. Wilson began his tenure on the Board in 1999. He recently resigned from the Board.



Mr. Wilson and Cheryl, his wife, have lived in the Heights since September 1981, and participated in various community volunteer organizations. Currently, Mr. Wilson is retired from his career as a fireman. He spent his entire career in service to the City of Santa Fe Springs and Disneyland Fire Department. From December 2007 to February 2009 he was the Board of Directors Vice-President. Mr. Wilson's fire career and expertise gave him a full understanding of a robust water supply system which greatly benefited the District's reservoir storage supply.

During Mr. Wilson's service, the District achieved completing \$16 million in capital projects. He also served on the Association of California Water Agencies/Joint Powers Insurance Authority (ACWA/JPIA) as the District's representative from January 2006 to December 2013. In addition, Mr. Wilson served on the Employee Benefits Committee which initiated the transition of employee health benefits to ACWA/JPIA from ACWA.
